

Enhanced General Data Dissemination System – e-GDDS

The International Monetary Fund (IMF) Enhanced General Data Dissemination System (e-GDDS) is a system for collecting and disseminating macroeconomic and financial data. The main goal of the e-GDDS is to improve the quality, transparency and timeliness of data, as well as the development of statistical systems. Publishing the most important data in one place ensures their comprehensiveness, timeliness and accessibility to all stakeholders for the analysis of macroeconomic and financial trends.

The data are published through the National Summary Data Page (NSDP), which is available on the website of the Republic Statistical Office, as well as on the International Monetary Fund's Dissemination Standards Bulletin Board (DSBB):

Fiscal data related to the execution of the central government budget and the general government budget, which have been published within e-GDDS since October 2021, are based on the GFSM 2014 public finance methodology, on a cash basis, which differs from the national methodology used for regular monthly reports in the section "Macroeconomic and fiscal data", so that there may be differences in the data concerning the result, as well as in certain revenue and expenditure categories.
